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MANAGEMENT BOARD REPORT

To Donors, Potential Donors, Members of the Advisory and Supervisory Board and Active YKIP Members.

In 2009 YKIP earned funds (donations plus interest) of Rp 1,849,884,784 (Approximately US \$146.468). Of this, Rp 666,951,056 (US \$52,807) was in unrestricted and Rp 1,182,933,729 (US\$93,661) was in restricted funds. In 2009, we spent more than we received since funding amounting Rp 5,367,750,000 (US\$425,000) was already received in 2008 but spent in 2009. Therefore, the actual restricted funds we received for 2009 were Rp 6,550,683,729 (US\$518,661). This was a year on year increase of 9.16 % and 19.71 % respectively.

With these donations and our reserves YKIP was able to fund the following projects.

This represents an increase of 47% on our 2008 Projects of Rp 3,261,440,261 (US\$ 357,536). The discrepancy between donations and expenses is because majority of our projects are multi year commitments for example funding a child's education for several years. In fact at the year end 2009, unrestricted reserves stand at only Rp 1,285,264,056 (US\$101,763), while restricted reserves stands at Rp 8,653,708,287 (US\$ 685,171). It is the Board's policy to keep an operating reserve so as to ensure YKIP can deliver on its commitments.

General and Administrative expenses excluding the impacts of exchange rate were Rp 743,741,541 representing a percentage of 10% over donations (including 2009 ALF Donation) and 13% over spending. The percentage of expenses over donation and projects spending were slightly increased compared to year 2008 which stands at 7% and 11% respectively.

All the above projects are fully described in a separate and detailed report.

We would like to thank every one who has contributed to the work YKIP has undertaken during the year including our Auditors Public Accounting Firm Drs. Paul Hadiwinata, Hidajat, Arsono, Ade Fatma and Associates which is part of the International PKF Association, who have again provided this audit probono.

1. General

Yayasan Kemanusiaan Ibu Pertiwi (the "Foundation") was established by deed No. 61 of notary public Josef Sunar Wibisono SH. dated 18 October 2002 and amended by deed No. 33 of Notary public Josef Sunar Wibisono, SH. dated 12 November 2002 and deed No. 56 of Josef Sunar Wibisono, SH., dated 26 February 2003. In relation with the Laws No. 16 year 2001, the Foundation's articles association has been changed by deed No. 40 dated 8 February 2005 and deed No. 42 dated 26 August 2006 of Josef Sunar Wibisono SH., a notary public in Denpasar.

The objectives of the foundation, as follow:

- Assisting to the victims of disaster, violence, criminal, terrorism, nature disaster, accident, and victims of other disaster in general;
- Providing the needs of medicines and medical supplies to the victims;
- c. Providing medical assistance and treatments for the victims;
- d. Carrying out other efforts which related and useful to achieve the aim and objectives of the Foundation and does not contrary to the prevailing laws and regulations.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Set out below is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Foundation in the preparation of its financial statements.

a) Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements

The financial statements have been prepared on the basis of historical costs and in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in Indonesia.

The statements of cash flows have been prepared using the direct method.

All figures presented in the notes to financial statements are expressed in Rupiah.

Revenue and Expense Recognition

Revenue from donation is recognized on cash basis.

Expenses are recognized base on accrual basis.

c) Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents consist of cash on hand and in banks, and short term deposits with maturity not more than six months at the date of placement and is no restriction of the usage.

d) Fixed assets

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Fixed assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and provision for impairment value, if any. Fixed assets are depreciated using double declining balance method based on the estimated useful lives as follows:

Computers	50 %
Office equipments	50 %
Vehicles	25 %

The cost of repairs and maintenance is charged to expense as incurred. Expenditures which extend the future life of assets or provide further economic benefits by increasing capacity are capitalized and depreciated based on applicable depreciation rate. When assets are retired or otherwise disposed of, their carrying value and the related accumulated depreciation are eliminated from the financial statements and the result gain or losses are recognized in the statements of activities.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies (continued)

e) Foreign Currency Transactions and Balances

The foundation maintains its accounting record in Indonesian Rupiah.

Transaction involving foreign currencies are recorded at Bank Indonesia's middle rates at the time the transactions are made. At the balance sheet date, assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies have been translated at Bank Indonesia's middle rate. The net foreign exchange gains or losses are recognized in the current year's statements of activities.

As of 31 December 2009 and 2008, the exchange rate used for US\$ 1 is Rp 9,400 and Rp 10,950, respectively.
